3.1 Example List of Common Hazards

- Fire escape doors; Risk of unsupervised exit from the facility.
- Unsupervised access to kitchen area; Risk of harm form e.g. burns and electric shock.
- Unsupervised excess to store / office Risk of children pulling supplies down on top of themselves.
- Inappropriate use of toys & equipment; Risk bruising cuts and grazes and other serious injury.
(E.g. Pool Cues, Pool balls, pens, pencils, paint brushes, skipping ropes, foot balls etc.)

- Items being thrown across the room; Risk injury to other children and breakage to lights and windows etc.
- Inappropriate use of scissors staplers; Risk of cuts and serious injury.
- Aggressive roll play and disputes; Risk of head and limy injury.
- Hot foods at snack time; Risk of burns and scalding.
- Allergies to foods; Risk of anaphylactic shock.
- Socket covers not being replaced; Risk of electric shock.
- Trailing electric leads; Risk of trips and falls.

- The unauthorised introduction of sharp implements, e.g., children bring in items from home; Risk of cuts and puncture injurers.

- Sharp knives and cooking utensils; Risk of cuts and serious injury.
- Use of drawing pins and staples; Risk of ingestion and injury.
- Tears in floor coverings; Risk of trips and falls.
- Damaged and broken toys; Risk of cuts from sharp and serrated edges.
- Unauthorised introduction of portable electric devices, without Pat. Testing certificate; Risk of malfunction and electric shock.

- Fire escape doors and routs blocked; Risk of falls crushing and serious injury including fatality from fire during evacuation.
- Inappropriate storage of supplies in hall ways etc.; Risk of blocking escape routes.
- Misuse of cleaning on progress and wet floor signs; Risk of slips and trips.
- The prolonged disposal of waste materials: Risk of infection and slips and trips.
- Water spillages; Risk of slips and falls.
- The placement of art and craft on walls; Risk of combustible material falling onto radiators.
- Inappropriate use of chairs and tables; Risk of falls from standing on or jumping off.
- Electric and fuse boards; Risk of electric shock, KEEP LOCKED AT ALL TIMES.

- Emergences lighting e.g. Maintained lights and unattained led. Indicator lights not illuminated; Risk of falls, crushing and serious injury during evacuation including fatality from fire.

This list is not exhaustive and should be added to as and when other hazards are identified.
