

We look forward to meeting all the new P4 pupils on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> August. Here are some notes to help in preparing your child for the new and very different start back to school:

**To prevent spread of infection, each child should bring a pencil case of items to be used in class, only by him/herself. This should include:**

- Writing pencils
- Eraser
- Sharpener
- Colouring pencils
- 30cm ruler
- Gluestick

**A puzzle/activity book is also required. Please ask your child to label this.**

All the above items will remain under your child's desk and will not travel home. So you should keep similar items at home for completion of homework!

On a **DAILY BASIS** your child should come to school with:

- A schoolbag
- A water bottle (labelled)
- A coat (labelled)
- A packed lunch in a labelled bag (for first week and thereafter when not taking a school lunch)
- Homework/reading book (in folder provided by school after a few weeks)

Each **MONDAY**, after the first week:

If you are purchasing school lunches, it would be extremely helpful and hygienic to send the correct money in a **clear, see-through money bag**. A small sticker could convey child's name, amount and days. Therefore, teachers can see and check the money at a glance and without handling it.
