## Uploading to edenderry.org: Parent Help sheet

Dear Parent,

To view and upload pupil work log into the **Home Learning** section of the school website using the password **Ed20Tech**.


You will see the form below when you access your child's class page. Your child's work can be photographed and submitted, Monday to Friday between 9am and 3pm. Teachers will respond to submissions during their normal working hours.

To submit:

1. Take a photograph of your child's work.
2. Enter your child's name
3. Enter your parent email
4. Enter the name of the activity in the comment box e.g. Literacy, Numeracy
5. Click on 'Choose file' and select the photograph from your photo gallery.
6. Click on Add Comment to submit the work.


If you have been successful, you will receive the following message '**Your comment has been submitted for approval**'. Please try again if you do not see this message.
