Principles

Fun 4U Club is committed to the care of children and staff alike and first aid is an intergraded part of that care. When faced with a medical emergency of any degree we have to be able to respond with a calm and collective manner. Fun 4U Club as an employer promotes staff first aid training ensuring that our members of staff attend at least a basic first aid course as part of our staff training programme

Statement of Intent

Fun 4U Club believes that

- All staff should attend a basic First Aid course so if faced with someone needing medical attention they
 are able to respond in professional manner.
- Refresher courses should be offered to staff members at suitable intervals.
- The first Aid kits should be adequately stock to cope with all types of emergence.
- All staff members should be fully aware of the location of each First Aid kit within the facility.

Procedure

- First Aid kits should be checked at regular intervals, and restocked if necessary.
- Before caring out first aid treatment staff should adorn PPE in guidance with Covid 19 regulations. This is a face mask, disposable gloves and disposable apron. All equipment should then be double bagged and disposed of in an outside bin when treatment is complete.
- In the event of a First Aid kit being used all equipment must be returned to the kit after use.
- Under no circumstances is equipment to be removed from First Aid kits, to be used for any other application.
- All Fun 4U Club vehicles must carry First Aid kits at all times.
- A First Aid kit should always be carried with the group if they leave the facility.
